ABOUT THE PROGRAM

This program is a unique opportunity for Physiotherapy graduates. The Fellowship in Physiotherapy Oncology is both academically and clinically oriented program. The program is planned with educational objectives and has a strong and standard curriculum experienced teaching facility and good faculty supervision. This is a twelve months onsite fellowship program for professionals interested in the rehabilitation of cancer patients. MCC shall be the Primary site for the Program. JDT Islam College of physiotherapy shall be providing clinical sessions both in Online and Offline mode. Candidates shall be observing and Performing Physiotherapy Services at MCC. Specific skills are developed in assessment and management of impairments, disabilities and handicap with Oncology patients undergoing treatment and on Follow up.

OBJECTIVES OF THE PROGRAM

- 1. Post Operative oncology rehabilitation management
- 2. Bed Side Positioning & movement management in ICU and Clinical Setting.
- 3. Chest mobilisation in ICU and bed side management.
- 4. Scar tissue healing & scar mobilisation.
- 5. Post operative exercise for Medical surgical, bone transplant management.
- 6. Safety exercise prescription for cardiac & respiratory conditions.
- 7. Physical activity for cancer survival.
- 8. Biomechanical changes in joints & muscle after cancer affected regions.
- 9. Lymphedema drainage management.
- 10. Journal clubs
- 11. Clinical research protocol

For successful completion of the Program. The candidate will be subjected to Internal evaluation and Final

Examination.

Internal assessment of the candidates by faculty. (100 marks)

This will be done on a continual basis with respect to the overall objectives of the course, based on the prescribed textbooks and study materials.

Final examination – by both internal & external examiner.

2 theory papers (50 x 2 = 100 marks)

Clinical case discussion (50 x 2 = 100 marks)

Ward rounds, log book maintence
